Introduction

The Mid Canterbury Mountain Bike Club is looking to continually improve, extend and upgrade the cycling tracks and scenery along the Ashburton River. We strive to give new and existing riders the best possible experience and to future proof the area for recreational activities. Our club has been running since 2010 and over this time members have put countless hours into building, shaping and maintaining the River Trail Loop and Skills Park. The track we look after is now 12km long, runs from Melrose to Trevors Road and is enjoyed by up to 500 members of the public from Ashburton and Canterbury weekly. We host both social, training and competitive events with our annual 6 hour race attracting over 350 riders from around the South Island.

3 - Bronze Supporter

Cost

- Any smaller contributions to the club that doesn't meet the criteria of the other categories but the club feels needs acknowledging.

4 – Track Section Naming Sponsor

Cost

- Funding to around 75% of the cost developing a new section of track (by negotiation)
or

- Logo on our track marker on your section of track

- Logo on our email footer
- Logo on all our maps and brochures
- Offers of interest to club membership able to be posted on our Facebook page (by approval of club publicity person)

Period of Entitlements

All contributions that are not ongoing will expire to make room for newer sponsor logos except for track section naming sponsors. The club assesses sponsorships annually and organisations are given the opportunity to renew their sponsorship when they expire.
